Dear Property Owner/Interested Persons:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will conduct a public workshop for the above referenced project. The proposed improvement involves the I-75 (SR 93) Express Lanes from the SR 826 / Gratiigny Parkway interchange to NW 170th Street and SR 826 (Palmetto Expressway) from NW 103rd Street to NW 154th Street, for a distance of approximately 9 miles. The workshop will be held on Wednesday, February 27, 2013, at Shula's Hotel and Golf Club, Grand Slam Ballroom, 6842 Main Street, Miami Lakes, Florida 33014, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. A copy of the project display ad, including a location map for the workshop is enclosed. Also enclosed is a project fact sheet describing the proposed improvements for your information.

This public workshop is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. Department representatives will be on hand during the workshop hours to discuss the project and to answer questions. Residents are encouraged to come in and review this transportation improvement proposal. This letter is being sent to all property owners within at least 300 feet on either side of the proposed alignment.
